# Spotlight on..... Free Training from Fane Ltd for Parents, Carers or Volunteers at your School

### What training can we deliver?

- Paediatric First Aid (12 hours Nationally recognised meets Ofsted requirements)
- Emergency Paediatric First Aid or First Responder (3-6hrs)
- Food Safety
- Health & Safety
- Bespoke 3 hour sessions on (just about!) any health, safety or first aid topic

## Over 1,000 children per year involved in accidents within 500m of school!



An online index has been compiled by the research group Road Safety Analysis and Axa Car Insurance, who say it will help parents understand "the risks associated with the roads around their local schools to keep their children safe".

The website will show how many vehicle collisions, including those involving children, have happened within 500m (a third of a mile) of the school gate.

The tool draws on data from the past six years, which shows there were 85,814 child injuries on roads within a 500m radius of schools, the equivalent of 1,190 a month.

Only one in five schools had no children injured in accidents within that distance over that period, the researchers say.

Separate figures used by the site also suggest there were 557,200 vehicle collisions around schools in the period 2006 to 2011, the equivalent of six collisions per school per year on average.
